Breast Prosthesis

The decision to wear a breast prosthesis is a very personal choice. This is why SCOPe has women specialists who are certified in mastectomy products on staff in most offices. Patients will receive individualized care and answers to questions to help choose the right prosthesis for them.



The following factors should be taken into account when deciding to wear a breast prosthesis: shape, weight, color, texture, feel, and the individual's activity level. The breast prosthesis of today has been greatly improved. Due to advances in materials, the new prosthesis is designed to reproduce the weight, texture, and movement of a natural breast. Another great improvement is a prosthesis that adheres directly to the skin giving a more natural feel and appearance.

SCOPe accommodates the individual's needs by carrying a wide variety of preferred brands such as Amoena, American Breast Care (ABC), and Classique. SCOPe can also order any other brand that the patient may prefer.

SCOPe carries beautifully designed bras. These special bras have set-in pockets to securely hold your prosthesis in place.



Once the patient has decided on the prosthesis, Proper care is essential for long-lasting results. Delicate daily washing and careful drying is a must. Also, remember to store the form in its original container at night to help prolong its shape.

Insurance Coverage

Most insurance companies have some type of coverage for mastectomy products but coverage may vary. It is important to check with the insurance company prior to the first appointment with SCOPe. A SCOPe representative will be happy to assist in contacting the insurance companies if need be.
